Festive Starry Decoration



Not so much a card, as a decorative item today. After, experimenting with the Stunning Stars 3D stars template, I stumbled upon the idea to make some quick decorative stars, that you can fix into a vase or pot and put in the middle of your festive table.

Actually, mine are sitting in a pyramid box in matching card, which has been made from an upcoming freebie template, which is not shown in the photo but will be posted soon.



You can go wild with this one and make stars in different sizes, shapes and cards but I have used the first of the five pointed stars and a seven pointed star here, both in size 4 (the smallest size).

You may have noticed that I'm heavily into the silver theme this year for some reason - I love the glittery silver ribbon I had in my bits and pieces box, so that might have something to do with it. Anyway, go for a shiny card, as this shows up the embossing really well.

The stars are made as shown on a previous blog post, using two stars sandwiched together with the tabs, which creates a lovely 3D effect. As noted above, I've embossed my stars with snowflakes and swirls, to add extra interest. My sticks are just skewers painted with some silver paint and then fixed inside the stars before assembling them (make sure you are using a good tacky glue, glue gun or better still a solvent glue here) to secure the sticks properly.
