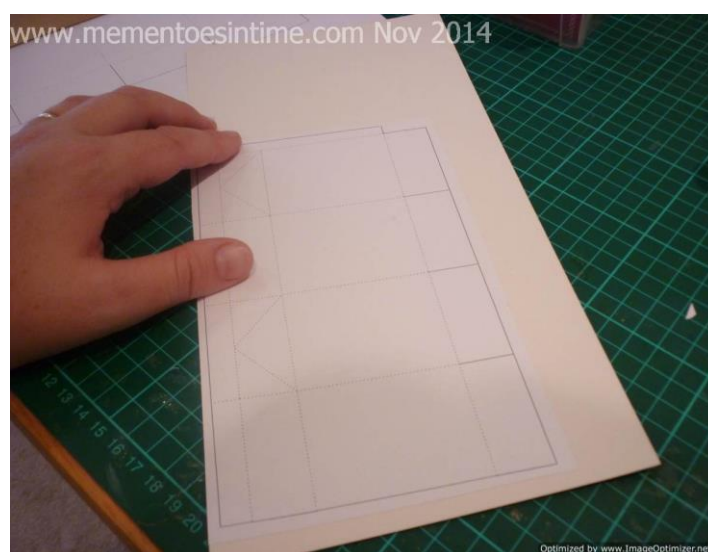


Mini Milk Carton Projects



Thank you to those who have thanked us for the template and I hope that you have some fun with it. Today, I am going to post a quick photo 'how to' and some projects you can make with the template.



I find the easiest way to use the template is to print onto paper and then glue to the reverse of my paper. I'm using a stiff scrapbook paper here, as card will be too thick to fold.



Score along the dotted lines. It's worth doing this well, as the sharper the creases, the easier it will be to fold.



I've turned my paper over, so you can see the folds and cuts.



Assembly is pretty self-explanatory but the tricky bit is the top, where you need to pinch the sides in together to form the folded in side pieces.



Secure the top by punching some holes, threading with string or ribbon and adding some mini pegs for embellishment. I've created a stamped, embossed flower for the front of this one, which I've layered up to create a 3D effect. You could also use one of our layering templates for this bit.

Make up a whole batch for friends and family, adding your own special touches! Next time, we will have another project using this template.
