

Starry Banner

I like dangly things and there is nothing better than making 'dangly' or 'hangy' things at Christmas as far as I am concerned. Nothing rude intended there!

A couple of years back, we had a banner of stockings hanging on a string and a few days ago, there was the milk carton advent calendar. There have been others, although the details escape me for the moment.



Anyway, here is another similar project, that I actually have on my lounge wall now, even though there are no other Christmas decorations up at all. I've made this little swag/banner using a mixture of the smaller stars from the Stunning Stars template and actually did it to use up all my odd bits and pieces of Christmas papers I had hanging around the office.

Simply make a range of 3D stars using the template, by cutting out two of each star that you are using, scoring and pinching them and then sandwiching them together with glue. You can choose from two different five pointed designs, a six and a seven pointed star. The six and seven pointed stars look the nicest for this project.

Tip: I find it easier to print out the stars, glue them to the reverse of my paper and then cut them out.

Now just randomly peg them to a string. Very easy but lovely to look at!
