

Christmas Box Cards



I love surprises and surprise cards are no exception. Open the box to reveal a sweet Christmas scene.

Today's project is to make a window box card, based upon the [aperture box template already covered in an earlier blog post](#). It has been adapted slightly and you can get the amended template on our freebie pages.

Make up the box in the same way as the [window aperture box](#). Create a scene inside with stamps or die cuts, layering the elements with foam pads to create depth.



This card uses the Stampin Up ' City of David' Stamp in the foreground, stamped onto acetate and coloured in. The background has an acrylic city stamp image, with handcut sand dunes, edged with chalk and a chalked sky.

Here is another card:



A traditional snow scene, with glitter card snow and a glittery sticker tree. The stars are just dots of glitter glue.



Work up your scene from the back to the front, adding a few layers to give depth.
