

## Delightful Doily Cards

I was cleaning out my cupboard and came across a couple of packets of doilies. I've never used them to make cards but had a great time playing around with them, to come up with some Christmas card making ideas. These would make great projects for the kids to do.



Doilies come in different colours but the easiest to find are the white ones. I found some gold ones too, which looked particularly festive. I'm using the mini doilies you can buy in the dollar store, to put your glasses on, rather than the larger ones you might use on a cake stand or plate.

For the Christmas tree, you just need to cut three sections of your doily, each a bit smaller than the last and then just layer them up. You can colour your white doily or use a gold one, they both look quite nice, when decorated and mounted on a card. I've used an ink pad to brush over the doily for the green tree.



You can also make rather a nice Christmas Wreath, just by cutting out the centre piece. If kids are making these, you can do this for them. You can use a craft knife or gently fold the doily in half and cut out the semicircle with scissors.



You can even cut some bell shapes from the doilies and mount them with a little ribbon.
