

## Easy Star Christmas Cards Part 2



Following on from our last post on super-easy Christmas cards, here is another star card that is simple but really effective.

By using beautiful handmade papers, you really don't have to do much to get something which looks pretty expensive and very 'Christmassy'. This card really is simplicity itself to make and the lovely paper puts it in a class of its own.

What you need:

- Cream square card blank
- A piece of handmade paper - this one came from the rather wonderful [Halcyon Steppe paper company](#)
- [A chipboard star](#) or a [glitter star](#) (both available in the webstore)
- Some gold thread
- Gold acrylic paint (*not needed if you use a glitter or painted star*)
- Some good craft glue, some double-sided tape or stick glue

Cut your handmade paper to size and stick it to your card blank. If you are using a chipboard star, you will need to paint it with some acrylic gold paint and set it aside to dry. If you don't have time, you could paper your star with gold paper or choose a ready painted star or a [glitter star](#) instead.

Now take a piece of gold thread - about 20 cm - and wind it around your star. Secure this with double sided tape on the reverse.

Now simply glue your star in place with some craft glue and you are finished!
