

Father's Day Apron Cards

For those in the Antipodes, Father's Day is approaching, so here are a couple of ideas, using the Apron Card Template. You can of course use the template for other occasions, like birthdays etc. Anyway, here are the piccies...



The first one is accessorised with some cute mini kitchen tools from Darice and the message card is from our new Father's Day freebie printables sheet, coming soon to the Freebie pages. I've added some shading around it and a hand drawn line, just to define it a bit more.

This next one is accessorised with mini tools, also from Darice and a hammer which is actually from a set of brads that I found in a discount shop. Its amazing what you can stumble across, when you aren't looking for anything in particular. The little ruler was made with a small strip of chipboard, inked up and marked with pen.

I've added a smaller pocket at the top of the next one and this is included as a template on the freebie printables sheet. The screw top brads come from Spotlight.

Tip: Adding some chalks around the edge, gives the card more depth and stitches add detail.



Here is one in blue, with a mechanic theme. I would have used buttons at the top, if I had some but the brads work quite well.
