

## Hanging Heart Card



Here is another freebie for you this time for a multi-use template, hence the name 'Combination Cards'. You can use this template to make a folded heart that you can fix to the front of your card (demo to come) or to make a full 3D hanging heart, as in the card shown above.

I love aperture cards with things hanging inside, as they are so interesting and interactive for the recipient. I haven't thought how to put this in an envelope but as it is not going to be posted, I suppose it isn't really too much of a problem.

I've actually made this card for my hubby (shh don't tell him) and gone for the pink rather than red colour scheme, as this is my preference. The heart is suspended so that each side rotates to show a different stamped message.



I've rubbed the edges of the heart with some distressed inks....message to self... I should make sure my sponges are clean before inking, as you can see a brownny/orange tinge to the heart which was not intended.

The aperture was cut using an oval template and dusted around the edges with chalks. I've just used a simple textured card for this project as I wanted the heart to be the focus. I also wanted to use silver cord to hang my heart so that the bow stood out but you could use thread instead and the heart will rotate more freely.
