

Layered Scallop Tree Card



Here is our next project in the Christmas Countdown Series. A lovely layered tree that takes only minutes to put together. Use up all those scraps in your stash and make a stack of these!



Cut out the pieces and fold along the dotted lines, so that the tabs are on underneath, this will give the 3D effect when you stick them down. You have three different sizes of layered tree to choose from on the template, I've gone for the largest size here. I've used a mixture of plain and patterned paper for my tree, as they were the pieces in my 'scrap box'. The plain pieces are embossed with 'Swiss Dots' embossing folder to give a bit of texture.



Start with the largest piece and then add each of the next layered pieces to form a tree shape, overlapping them as you go and sticking them in such a way that they each bow outwards.



Add a little gold star to the top to finish and a handcut pot for a base.

The template includes layered scallops in 3 different sizes, which you can just print and cut onto your paper or cut them out and use them as templates to draw around.
