

Layered Tree Card



For our next project in the [24 Days of Christmas Series](#), we have a super cute 3-D Christmas Tree. This is a nice project for the kids to do, or even the 'big kids'!

I've printed my pieces direct to a thin card and embossed them to give it a bit more interest, before layering them up. Start with the largest piece and work up from there.

Tip: stick the tabs down close enough, so that they curve out and give your tree dimension. You could use a pencil to shape the pieces if you like. Shape the pot as well.

My background is simply an embossed rectangle of card and there is a gold border sticker around the outside to finish it off. The tree is trimmed with some glitter glue and stick on pearls and topped with a punched glitter star.
