

Snowflake Card Number 3



We return to the 'Nice to Snow You' template today, as I was getting a bit fed up of posting milk carton projects, so I will post the final one of those projects next time and do a card today.

Today's card is big and brash and very, very shiny! I **love** glittery shiny things and this card totally fits the bill. A large, layered embossed snowflake design mounted on lovely blue and silver background paper, to create a luxurious finish. This is another example of a card that the photo doesn't do justice to.

Our theme this year has definitely been snowflakes and most of the demo cards have been made using either one or both of the ['Nice to Snow You'](#) card template as well as the free snowflakes shapes. This card combines the two, to create a layered effect.



The ['Nice to Snow You'](#) card template makes folding cards in 5 sizes but you can use just one side of it to cut large snowflakes, as I have done here. I'm using a silver card and added texture with an embossing folder.



Cut two more (or more if you wish), using smaller sizes from the template. You can use the smallest size from the free template if you wish. Emboss them in the same way.



Now just start layering them up using some foam pads to create the height. Be aware that this card won't be going in an envelope!



A few sparklies in the middle is a nice touch to finish!
