

## Teddy in a Basket



I'm wondering whether anyone can spot the rather obvious but not deliberate mistake on this card I have made for my niece.

Have you got it yet?

OK, I'll tell you, stupidly, I've made a card that opens the wrong way!

Actually it rather nicely demonstrates an easy mistake to make if you tend to glue and stick templates to the reverse of your card, as I always do. The card I wanted to use was gold on one side, so I glued the template to the reverse and just cut it out but that of course meant that the card would open the wrong way, when you cut it out and folded it.

I wasn't sure what to do with this, because believe it or not, I didn't notice at all, until I had finished decorating it and then I couldn't be bothered to fix it! I thought I would post a photo of it anyway, just because I had put all the effort in.

Anyway, the original purpose of this post was that I'm on a bit of a mission to revisit some of the older templates on the website and give them a festive twist. I'm using the [Easter and Flower Basket](#) template here. My die cut teddy hanging out of the basket is a recent acquisition, he is actually the smaller of the two sizes on the die and I love the way he hangs over the edge of anything you put him on.
