

Wreath Card



Shaped cards can be so effective and really stand out, which is a good thing when your card is competing with lots of others being displayed. So here is an idea for a lovely but very simple wreath card for Day 4 of our 24 Days of Christmas Series.

Using our free template, you can create a wreath and then decorate with punched flowers, stars, ribbons and whatever spare or leftover trims you have in your stash. I've run my card through a Cuttlebug embossing folder to give some extra texture but you could use stamped images as well.
