

Beautiful Girl Photo Screen



Daughters are a blessing and a curse I feel. At times, I wonder why I chose to be a parent and at others I am bowled over by the beauty and wonder of my girls. This screen celebrates a daughter, with quotes and photos and has been made using the chipboard screen kits in the webstore.

I really loved doing this project because it felt like doing a scrapbook page, making a gift and a decorative piece all rolled into one!

What you Need

Chipboard Screen Kit or Downloadable Template, selection of photos, acrylic paints in your choice of colours, Cuttlebug embossing plate (we used Deb Devine), Tim Holtz distressed ink, selection of die cut frames and mats, ribbons, paper flowers, die cut tag, metal wording plates, rubber stamps of your choice, Perfect Pearls powder to finish.

Each kit has three separate chipboard panels for you to decorate. You can paint, ink or paper them as you wish. I have run these panels through the Cuttlebug using a Cuttlebug textile effect embossing folder called Deb Devine (one of the Australian designs) to give a lovely textured finish.

I then painted it with an off white acrylic from Kaisercraft and used Tim Holtz distressed ink (Tattered Rose) around the edges. Finally, Ranger Perfect Pearls were brushed over the surface to give a shine.

The screen was tied together with ribbons, after punching holes using a Cropadile, but you can use tape to link them together on the back if you wish.

The screen has been decorated with Sizzix die cut frames and tags, brushed with distressed inks and embellished with flowers, stick on metal words and stamped wording.
