

Mini Chipboard Clipboard Notelets



Preparation for the school fete continues!. Following on from the previous [mini clipboard project](#) posted on the blog, here are some even smaller ones, made in the same way but this time with some cute stamped images on the front pages.

To make this project, you will need some mini chipboard pieces, with the edges rounded off. You can cut your own to any size you like, or we have some available in the webstore complete with mini clips. These measure 5cm by 4cm.

All you need to do is glue some paper onto both sides of the chipboard. This is a great project for using up those scrap pieces of paper you don't know what to do with. Try to go for papers with a small pattern as the surface to cover is quite small. I have gone for different papers on each side, so it can be flipped over and used the other side.

You can then add your mini notebook. I couldn't find notes small enough, so I just cut my own (4cm x 3cm) using a guillotine. I have stamped the front page with a mini stamp, most of these are from Hero Arts (Playful Animals) but any small cute stamp will do.

I don't particularly like the clip showing, so I have glued some paper flowers onto them with a solvent craft glue and a little stick on gem in the middle.



I am not sure whether to add some magnets to the back so they can be stuck on the fridge.
Any thoughts?
