

Valentines Project – Heartfelt Wishes



Okay so I am not the most romantic person in the world but I do like to let people know how much I appreciate them. I wanted to make something a bit different for Valentine's Day for my hubby to let him know how special he is, so here is a cute little project using the new free template (see the members' pages).



To make this project you will need four or five chipboard hearts in whatever size you want. I have made these from hearts measuring about 4.5cm across.

Now you need to decorate them with co-ordinating papers (I have just used pieces from my scrap basket), gluing them securely to each side of each heart.

You could paint, stamp, ink and emboss the hearts instead to get any kind of look you like but I wanted a simple red colour scheme for mine. You can rub around the edges with some distressed inks too if you want a slightly worn appearance as I have done here.



Then punch holes in the top of your hearts and thread them onto a keyring. Now is the fun part! Print out your heartfelt messages or handwrite them onto scraps of paper and glue to your hearts. Finish off with a piece of ribbon tied onto the keyring.

And there you have it...a quick and simple way to get the message across to your loved one and it really is lovely as it is so tactile. If you seal the hearts with some varnish or glossy accents, they will be more durable and can be hung on a proper keyring.

I also made one each for my gorgeous daughters (in pink of course) and picked out individual sentiments for each one.
