

Easy Christmas Star Cards Part 3



Here is part three in our series of super easy star cards. I love this card, as it looks just like a luxury card but really can be made in big batches. The colour-scheme of cream and gold really gives a classy finish but it looks equally nice in a silver theme.

What you need:

- An A6 cream textured card blank
- A rectangle of mirror card in gold or silver
- A roll of organza ribbon (wired is best) - readily available from the \$2 store.
- A Pack of Star Clips
- Some gold/silver thread (optional)
- Some craft glue and double-sided tape.
- Sticker or stamped greeting

Firstly cut a piece of your ribbon, about 10cm should do. Cut a piece of mirror card (approx 5cm x 6.5cm) and wrap the ribbon around the card.

Now take some gold thread (about 30cm) and wrap it around the card vertically. You don't have to do this but it gives a nice effect of the star attached to the strings.

Next you need to glue your star clip and this is where the good strong craft glue comes in. I use a solvent based clear glue, available from most craft stores and DIY stores. The glue should dry clear but it is always wise to take care. Once you have made your 'topper' you can fix it to your card blank with some double-sided tape. You can add a sticker or stamped greeting underneath.

Here is the same card in silver:



Make up a batch and have them ready to make up into cards at the last minute!
