

# Easy Star Christmas Cards

If are looking for some easy and straightforward but very effective Christmas card ideas, then here is a project for you.



These are super quick to do, and always get plenty of compliments. This simple design was among my best selling cards last year, in both red and gold and blue and silver combinations and is an ideal way to produce a pack of cards quickly and easily for your own use or for sale.

## What you need:

- Square cream card blank and envelope
- Gold/silver mirror card square
- Piece of Christmas fabric (the fabric stores have plenty at this time of year) edged with pinking shears
- [Gold/silver star embellishments](#) (available from the webstore)
- Craft Glue/good strong glue to attach your star.

The material is see through and so I don't tend to glue it to the mirror board but simply attach the star with a good glue and this will hold the material in place. The effect of the star reflected in the board behind the material is quite lovely and there is no limit to the different effects, you can get by choosing different Christmas fabrics.
